Prayer in Times of Peace Will Prepare God's People for Times of Trouble at the End, cont'd

- We are living in the most solemn period of this world's history. The destiny of earth's teeming multitudes is about to be decided. The period of probation is granted to all to prepare for that time. Jacob prevailed because he was persevering and determined. His victory is an evidence of the power of importunate prayer.
